

Welcome Message



The 2020 Texas ACSM annual conference will be held Thursday, February 20 and Friday, February 21 at the Waco Convention Center located at 100 Washington Avenue in Waco, TX. We have both our clinical and science tracks again this year to provide more variety to the meeting. Our vendor booths will be open both days in Chisholm Hall. Please stop by and visit them early and stay late. Parking is free this year in Heritage Square surrounding the Waco Convention Center.

Thursday afternoon is packed with stimulating topics and dynamic speakers. We will start with the "New to Texas"

tutorial lecture by Dr. Jody Greaney from the University of Texas at Arlington. SRDA presentations will continue with five-minute presentation rounds and competition for additional monies to be given to first, second, and third place winners. Additionally, we have presentations from Dr. Frank Dinenno, a National ACSM award winner from Colorado State University, followed by Dr. Grant Simmons from the Nike Sport Research Lab. The science track will conclude Thursday with concurrent sessions from Dr. Hiro Tanaka, past TACSM president, from the University of Texas at Austin and the Gatorade Sports Science Institute Talk given by Lisa Heaton.

The clinical track presentations stand to be equally engaging and begin Thursday at 2:55 p.m. with a professional roundtable presentation from several experts in the fields of medicine, athletic training, physical therapy, nutrition, and sports psychology followed by Dr. Sushmita Purkayastha from Southern Methodist University who will present about cerebral flow impairments following concussion. Dr. Stephen Singleton from Fort Worth Orthopedics concludes the clinical track presentations on Friday at 10:30 a.m.

Poster set-up begins Thursday from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m. with viewing and judging from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. The social starts at 6:00 p.m. and will not disappoint with finger foods and complimentary beer and wine in Chisholm Hall. For those that are interested, there will be an informal meet and greet at Cricket's Grill & Drafthouse which is within walking distance across from the Waco Convention Center. Posters will remain up both days this year. Please make sure to take your posters down Friday from 2:00 to 4:30 p.m.

Friday starts bright and early with the TACSM Student Bowl XI competition. We will have complimentary continental breakfast available as well. Tutorial lectures begin with our Honor Award recipient, Dr. Stephen Crouse from Texas A&M University. After a lunch from Miller's Smokehouse, Dr. Paul Fadel will be giving this year's Raven Lecture followed by Dr. Ollie Jay from the University of Sydney presenting the inaugural TACSM International Scholar's Lecture. Presentations will conclude with power packed, concurrent sessions by Dr. Kenneth Clark from West Chester University and Dr. Christopher Hearon, Jr. from the Institute for Exercise & Environmental Medicine and UT Southwestern. We will conclude with the awards ceremony at 3:50 p.m. as we close out the 2020 Annual Meeting.
